Email course descriptions to GS office for pre-approval for selected courses.



PETITION

with your academic advisors to apply UCEAP course credit toward your degree requirements upon return.

GLOBAL STUDIES ABROAD

UCEAP COURSES MAY BE APPLIED TOWARD:

- **Major and Minor Courses**
Preparatory courses: must be lower division
Upper Division: must be ≥ 4 units, upper division
Petition and approval required & must be taken for letter grade
- **Foreign Language Courses**
Discuss with applicable language department as they must follow guidelines set by such department.

OTHER NOTES

- To be pre-approved, all elective courses must focus on globalization and core courses must cover the same material as the ones offered at UCLA.
- Students are not restricted to taking courses only in their major abroad.
- At least 6 UD courses must be taken at UCLA toward the Glbl St major.
- Some programs may have internship options
 - Global Studies, Geneva (Switzerland)
 - Irish Parliament Internship (Ireland)

TERMS ABROAD

Study abroad is possible as early as summer after your first year, as late as summer after your last year.

Consider if any UCLA classes are only offered in specific terms at UCLA (GLBL ST 102, 103, 104, 191, 194, and Summer Travel Study). Also note that some courses must be taken sequentially.
